C) Agreement

- A student cannot request a formal grade appeal unless he/she/them has first made an informal appeal to the instructor.
- A student may appeal a grade in any subject within 30 calendar days after the end of the course; or, in the case of Apprenticeship programs within 10 days after receipt of the marks.
- Formal appeals are to be submitted using this form, accompanied by payment of \$105 for each grade appealed, and to the Office of the Registrar.
- This fee will be refunded only if the appeal is awarded in favour of the appellant.
- The grade appeal shall be considered, and normally a decision is rendered within 10 working days from the date Office of the Registrar notifies the Dean or designate of the grade appeal.
- Appeal decisions are final and binding. The Dean shall advise the student in writing of the appeal decision.
- A student who accepts a method to remedy a course deficiency, and who is not successful, is not eligible to appeal the original grade. Likewise, a student who is unsuccessful in appealing a grade will be unable to request a remedy of course deficiency.
- A student who received a final grade as a result of academic or non-academic conduct are not eligible to appeal their grade
